Target Audience: County Maintenance crews, Local Public Works Departments, Tribal Communities and the Oklahoma Department of Transportation

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This two-day course covers the tests used to determine the engineering characteristics of soils used to construct roadways and embankments. Sieve analysis, Atterburg limits, Proctors and Nuclear density tests are discussed/demonstrated. Emphasis is placed on explaining how these test can be used to improve the characteristics of soils through the use of soil amendments.

INSTRUCTOR: Dr. Heather Yates, ED.D., CPC; Dr. Yates joined OSU CMT Faculty in 2006. She received her Bachelor of Science in Engineering Technology from OSU in 1998. In 2002, she graduated with a Masters of Engineering Technology from Pittsburg State and completed her Doctorate in Higher Education in 2012 from OSU. She is currently an Associate Professor and Program Coordinator for Construction Engineering Technology at OSU.
